Civil Money Penalties

- Family Smoking Prevention and Tobacco Control Act: Section 103(q)(2)(A)(i)
 - To a retailer with an approved training program, the amount of the civil penalty shall not exceed:
 - 1st violation – issuance of a warning letter to the retailer
 - 2nd violation within a 12 month period – \$250
 - 3rd violation within a 24 month period – \$500
 - 4th violation within a 24 month period – \$2,000
 - 5th violation within a 36 month period – \$5,000
 - 6th or subsequent violation with in a 48 month period – \$10,000 (on a case-by-case basis)

Civil Money Penalties

- Family Smoking Prevention and Tobacco Control Act: Section 103(q)(2)(A)(ii)
 - To a retailer that does not have an approved training program, the amount of the civil penalty shall not exceed:
 - 1st violation – \$250
 - 2nd violation within a 12 month period – \$500
 - 3rd violation within a 24 month period – \$1,000
 - 4th violation within a 24 month period – \$2,000
 - 5th violation within a 36 month period – \$5,000
 - 6th or subsequent violation with in a 48 month period – \$10,000 (on a case-by-case basis)
