3. SERVICES PERFORMED BY THIS DEALERSHIP FOR SUCH FEE:

- Processing and submission of credit applications to finance companies.
 - Preparation of finance or lease documents.
 - Preparation and submission of vehicle registrations both manually and electronically with the Connecticut Department of Motor Vehicles.
 - Filing and releasing security liens on purchased and traded vehicles as contractually required by lending institutions.
 - Processing applications for new or duplicate title documents with the Connecticut Department of Motor Vehicles.
