## LEGAL NOTICE

On January 4, 2011, the Commissioner of Agriculture, upon the application of Robert Griffith 19 Crooked Trail, Rowayton, CT 06853, will lease to the highest responsible bidder, shellfish grounds in Greenwich totaling 79.5 acres as follows:

Beginning at a point being the southeast corner of lease 641 and the northeast corner of the piece herein described;

Thence South 12 Degrees 47 Minutes 28 Seconds East, a distance of 2315.29 feet to a point being the southeast corner of the piece herein described;

Thence South 80 Degrees 57 Minutes 42 Seconds West, a distance of 1861.73 feet to a point being the southwest corner of the piece herein described;

Thence North 00 Degrees 32 Minutes 22 Seconds East, a distance of 2016.11 feet to a point being the northwest corner of the piece herein described;

Thence North 67 Degrees 46 Minutes 00 Seconds East, a distance of 1412.03 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING.
