

LEGAL NOTICE

Beginning at a point on the westerly line of Lease 379 being the southeast corner of Lease 624;

Thence along the southerly line of Lease 379 South 00 Degrees 09 Minutes 55 Seconds East, a distance of 775.05 feet to a point being the southwest corner of Lease 379;

Thence South 57 Degrees 42 Minutes 48 Seconds West, a distance of 3476.97 feet to a point being the northeast corner of Lease 602 and the southeast corner of Lease 596;

Thence along the easterly line of Lease 596, North 00 Degrees 25 Minutes 38 Seconds East, a distance of 1226.66 feet to a point on the easterly line of Lease 596 being the southwest corner of Lease 624;

Thence along the southerly line of Lease 624, North 64 Degrees 21 Minutes 19 Seconds East, a distance of 3247.93 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING.
