## LEGAL NOTICE

Beginning at a point being the northeasterly most point of the lot herein described and having a latitude of 41°-14.026' and a longitude of 72°-46.377' ;

Thence along the easterly line of the lot herein described, South 0 Degrees 00 Minutes 55 Seconds West, a distance of 1706.43 feet to a point being the southeast corner of the lot herein described;

Thence along the southerly line of the lot herein described, North 89 Degrees 58 Minutes 58 Seconds West, a distance of 1742.14 feet to a point being the southwest corner of the lot herein described;

Thence along the westerly line of the lot herein described, North 0 Degrees 01 Minutes 10 Seconds East, a distance of 1706.43 feet to a point being the northwest corner of the lot herein described;
