Beginning at a Buoy, #661 which is 2,191.93 meters west of Longitude 72 degrees, 57 minutes, 00 seconds

West, 2.81 meters North of Latitude 41 degrees, 13 minutes, 00 seconds North, being the northeast corner

of the parcel herein described; thence along a line South 31 degrees, 59 minutes, 00 seconds East, 330.98

meters to a point marked by Buoy #663; thence along a line South 58 degrees, 00 minutes, 02 seconds

West, 611.35 meters to a point marked by Buoy #664; thence along a line North 31 degrees, 59 minutes,

00 seconds West, 330.98 meters to a point marked by Buoy #665; thence along a line North 58 degrees,

00 minutes, 02 seconds East, 611.35 meters to the point or place of beginning.

Located within the meridian boundaries of the Town of West Haven, (State Jurisdiction).

Shellfish growing classification is "Conditionally Approved".
