

Wine at Connecticut Farmers' Markets

Sales of wine is permitted at Connecticut farmers' markets. This is regulated by the Connecticut Department of Consumer Protection – Liquor Control Division.

Only applicants with an active manufacturer permit for a farm winery to be eligible for this permit. Approved applicants can be approved for up to three (3) farmers' market locations. These market may be in operation Monday through Saturday. No Sunday wine sales at Connecticut farmers' markets will be permitted.
