Notice of Intent to Adopt Regulations

In accordance with section 4-168(a) of the Connecticut General Statutes, notice is hereby given that the Commissioner of Agriculture, pursuant to the authority of section 22-128a of the Connecticut General Statutes, proposes to adopt regulations concerning the fees for milk producer and milk transport tanker registration applicable to milk producers and milk transporters.

Statement of Purpose: To establish fees for milk producer and milk transport tanker registration.

(NEW) Sec. 22-128a-3. Registration of bulk milk pickup or transport tankers as provided for in section 22-203h of the Connecticut General Statutes.

- (a) The fee for a bulk milk pickup or transport tanker permit shall be ten dollars per bulk milk tanker registered.
- (b) The permit shall be designated "Bulk Milk Tanker".
- (c) The bulk milk tanker permit shall be issued to the person, company or firm which operates one or more bulk milk tankers. The registration shall contain the identification of each permitted tanker, may be reproduced and must be carried on each permitted tanker.

Section 1. The Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies are amended by adding sections 22-128a-2 and 22-128a-3, as follows:

(NEW) Sec. 22-128a-2. Registration of producers as provided for in section 22-172 of the Connecticut General Statutes.

- (a) The fee for the registration of a producer shall be ten dollars.
- (b) Each place where milk is produced shall be registered as a separate entity.
- (c) The registration shall be designated "Milk Producer" and shall be posted in the milk room on the premises.
- (d) The registration shall be renewed annually in the month of May.
