

2010 Holiday Program Notice

This year the Holiday program will consist of several items added to your regular commissary form. Most items will be located in various areas of the commissary form and in bold letters. Other items may be ordered by using the write-in section. Holiday items delivery will be with your regular commissary order. This year the program will run from November 8 through December 17, 2010.

Money Orders

Money orders will be accepted beginning on November 01, 2010 through December 13, 2010. Only during those specific weeks will money orders be accepted from people not on your visiting list. Money orders received from those not on your visiting list will be limited to \$250.00.

Electronic Deposits

Only approved visitors specifically authorized to send funds electronically through Western Union can utilize this option. Approved visitors who wish to wire funds may sign up by completing a new visiting application form and checking off the EFT box on page 2. Once approved, funds sent electronically will be applied to your inmate account faster.

Ordering

During this program your spending limit will be increased to \$125.00 per week. Even if you are not buying any holiday items, you must use the form provided. You may order the additional items by selecting them just as you select other items. You will continue to have limits on each item, as is reflected by the quantities in each bubble. Do not attempt to go over those limits by using the write-in section – your order will be voided and you will lose a week of the program. Only items that say, “use write-in section” can be purchased using the write in section on the commissary form. We will make every effort to have all items in stock throughout this program. In cases where an item is out of stock there will be no substitution.

Delivery

The program will begin with the pickup of the holiday forms the week of November 8, 2010 and the first deliveries will be the week of November 15, 2010.

Important dates to remember:

- November 1** Holiday money from people not on the visiting list will be accepted.
November 8 Inmate spending limit is increased to \$125.00
November 8 Holiday forms will be processed. Make sure you are using the correct form.
November 15 The delivery of holiday items will begin.
December 13 Money orders from people not on the list must be received by the Inmate Trust Fund Unit by this date.
December 17 All holiday deliveries will be complete. Spending limit shall be reset. The program ends.

Limits

As always the items purchased must remain in compliance with the Directive 6.10 “Commissary items other than appliances and clothing, shall not accumulate in cell/ living areas in excess of two cubic feet.” You are responsible to be within those limits. The items listed below will be available during the program.
