AMNESTY PROGRAM FOR DELINQUENT LOTTERY SALES AGENTS

The Division of Special Revenue is conducting an amnesty program for delinquent lottery sales agents who currently owe money to the state of Connecticut. In accordance with the statute authorizing this program (Public Act No. 10-70) delinquent agents have 60 days from receipt of a notification letter from the Division of Special Revenue to pay the principal and penalty amount owed and 50% of the accumulated interest owed. The remaining 50% of interest owed will then be waived and the agent will no longer be delinquent to the state of Connecticut. Once the delinquency is paid the Division of Special Revenue will remove any lien or wage attachment it has instituted against the agent and his or her property.

An agent must pay the full principal and half the interest owed in one check and then the remainder 50% of interest will be waived. This amnesty program ends December 31, 2010.

The Division is in the process of mailing letters to all former and current delinquent lottery sales agents at their last known address, which will be completed by the end of October.
