Dear Mr. Penrose:

The Connecticut Gaming Policy Board on September 22, 2010 approved the transfer of the right to own and operate the Connecticut OTB System from Scientific Games Corporation to Sportech PLC pursuant to the terms of the 1993 Connecticut OTB System Purchase Agreement. Autotote Enterprise Inc. currently holds the Association License necessary to continue to operate the Connecticut OTB System. In accordance with the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies Section 12-574-F62 (f), Sportech PLC was issued an Association Affiliate License at the Board meeting subject to several conditions which will require the submission of additional administrative filings and associated licensure forms by December 1, 2010. Attached to this letter is a certified copy of the Gaming Policy Board's resolution.

The submission of the filings and associated licensure forms, post-approval and post-closing, is part of Sportech's on-going obligation to the Division as an Association Affiliate licensee and is consistent with the terms and requirements of the 1993 Agreement and past practices of the Division. The Division does recognize that some of the filings may take a while and the Gaming Policy Board has advised me that they would consider an extension should one become necessary.

As of the date of closing, Sportech PLC will be bound by all the provisions of the 1993 Agreement and Scientific Games Corporation will be unconditionally released from all obligations pursuant to that Agreement.

We would like to thank you and your team for all the hard work that has gone into this transaction thus far and we look forward to a long and successful relationship.
