

Trail Highlights

This trail is a section of the Farmington Canal Heritage Trail that is planned to run from New Haven, north to the Massachusetts border. This trail runs from its intersection with Route 4 and north crossing Brickyard Road and a parking area then proceeds to the Avon town line. This is the beginning of the northern section of this trail and is planned to continue south until it connects with the Southington section and eventually the Cheshire and Hamden sections as well.

Parking and Accessibility

A parking area is located on Brickyard Road approximately 1 mile north of Route 4.

From I-84: Take exit 39 to Route 4 West. Turn right onto Brickyard Road. The parking area is on the left.
