Trail Highlights



This trail is a section of the Farmington Canal Heritage Trail that is planned to run from New Haven, north to the Massachusetts border. This is the last section of the Farmington Canal Heritage Trail and begins at the East Granby town line. The trail runs north crossing Phelps Road and then continuing to the Massachusetts border.

Parking and Accessibility

There is no designated parking available for trail users.

From I-91 North and South: Take exit 40, the Route 20/Bradley Airport Connector. Follow Route 20 for 3 miles past the Bradley Airport exit and take a right onto Newgate Road. Take Newgate Road north for 4 miles until the intersection with Phelps Road. Take a left onto Phelps Road. The trail can be accessed where it crosses Phelps Road 0.9 miles from the intersection.
