



Burlington Farmington River Trail

Trail Highlights


This trail is a section of the Farmington River Trail, a 10.5-mile trail that begins at Meadow Road in Farmington and ends in Canton. This section is 3 miles in length and begins at the Farmington town line where it will meet Farmington's section of the trail. From this point the trail will run north following the Farmington River its entire path until its terminus at the Canton town line. Here the trail crosses the Farmington River and connects with Canton's portion of the trail.

Parking and Accessibility


Parking is available at a designated lot located off of Route 4 in Burlington, close to the intersection of Route 179 and Route 4.

From I-84: Take exit 39 to Route 4 West. Follow Route 4 for 6.8 miles to the parking lot located on the right side of the road, just before the intersection of Route 4 with Route 179.
