



## Simsbury Farmington River Trail

### Trail Highlights

This 3.7-mile section of the Farmington River trail begins at West Mountain Road in Simsbury and travels in a northeast direction. After traveling 1.7 miles, the trail meets Stratton Brook Road. Along the way it passes through Massacoe State Forest, and parallels Stratton Brook for 0.75 miles. The trail then continues an additional 1.25 miles before crossing Route 309. This stretch of trail travels through Stratton Brook State Park. After crossing Route 309, it continues for 0.7 miles to its terminus at Route 202. The trail will eventually connect Canton's section of the trail and the Farmington Canal Heritage Trail.



Some sections of this trail are not yet improved.

### Parking and Accessibility

Parking is available at Stratton Brook State Park.

**From I-84:** Take exit 32 and follow Route 10 north to the town of Avon. In Avon, follow Route 10 to Route 167, go west on Route 167 and bear right onto Route 309, and Stratton Brook State Park is on the left.

**From I-91:** Take exit 36 (Route 178) and follow Route 178 west to the intersection with Route 185. Follow Route 185 west to the intersection with Route 10/202. Turn north onto Route 10/202 and follow Route 167, go west on Route 167 then bear right onto Route 309, and Stratton Brook State Park is on the left.
