Trail Highlights



This trail originates at the Riverside Park Pedestrian Bridge in North Grosvenordale and runs along the outer perimeter of the local library and community center. The paved section of the trail will progress north along the French River and the west side of the North Grosvenordale Pond. Throughout its course, the path will cross Route 12, the former "River Street," Buckley Hill Road, and the state boat launch near the Knights Of Columbus. North of this point the trail will be a stone dust surface. The Heritage Way will terminate just south of the Fish Pond outlet. Bicyclists and rollerbladers will be encouraged along the paved stretch of the path, while the stone dust surface along the north portion of the trail will be better for walkers and joggers.

Parking and Accessibility

Parking is available at the library and community center, and Riverside Park.

From I-395 North: Take exit 98 and proceed north on Route 12 to North Grosvenordale. After crossing the French River, bear left on Main Street. Take the first left into the library to access the pedestrian bridge and Heritage Way.

From I-395 South: Take exit 99 and proceed west on Route 200. At the intersection with Route 12, bear right. Follow Route 12 north to North Grosvenordale and proceed as above.
