



## Vernon Rockville Spur

### Trail Highlights



This multi-use trail is 3.8 miles in length and runs along an abandoned railway that splits from the Vernon Rails to Trails Park and heads north to the historic center of Rockville. Once north of the footbridge across the Tankerhoosen River, which provides a scenic overlook of the river, the trail is unimproved to its terminus at Vernon Avenue.

### Parking and Accessibility

A parking lot is adjacent to the trail on Church Street and between Washington and Phoenix Streets.

**From I-84 East:** Take exit 65, turn right onto Hartford Turnpike, right onto Dobson Road, left onto Church Street, and left into the parking area.

**From I-84 West:** Take exit 66, turn left onto Whitney T. Ferguson III Drive, left onto Tunnel Road, right onto Warren Avenue (bear left to stay on Warren Avenue), turn left onto Phoenix Street, right onto Church Street, and then right into the parking area.
