

# Middletown **Westlake Area Bikeway**

### **Trail Highlights**

The trail begins on Middle Street at the intersection of Bradley Street and Aetna Drive. It proceeds south along Middle Street to Smith Street, then east on Smith Street, continuing under the I-91 overpass, to Westlake Drive. It then proceeds north on Westlake Drive to its terminus near Grandview Drive. This paved 8 foot wide trail is separated from the roadway and is located in a residential/commercial area and designed with special consideration for commuters. Cucia Park is located along the trail on the south side of Smith Street. The park contains a small pond. picnic area, and playscapes for children. The park can be accessed from the bike trail by crossing Smith Street.

There are steep grades along this section of trail. Use caution.


### **Parking and Accessibility**


Parking for 25 cars is available at Cucia Park on Smith Street.

From I-91 South: Take exit 21 (Route 372). At the end of the ramp, go straight and continue to the end of Industrial Park Road. Turn right onto Smith Street. Cucia Park is on the left.

From I-91 North: Take exit 20 (Country Club Road/Middle Street). Turn left at the end of the ramp onto Country Club Road. Take the first right onto Middle Street. Turn right at the first traffic light onto Smith Street. Cucia Park is on the right.
