PETITION FOR INCREASE IN TAXICAB RATES OF FARE

Pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes ("C.G.S.") Section 13b-96, as amended, and Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies ("RCSA") Section 13b-96-37, Yellow Cab Company of New London and Groton, Inc., Waterbury Yellow Cab & Service Company, Inc. (The) DBA Yellow Cab Company and Norwich Taxi, LLC (hereinafter "Petitioners") hereby respectfully petition the State of Connecticut Department of Transportation (hereinafter "Department"), for authorization to amend the metered rates of fare for taxicab operation.

I. REQUEST

Petitioners request that the Commissioner grant an increase in the taxicab metered rates of fare in Naugatuck, Waterbury, Watertown, Groton, New London, Newtown, Southbury, Waterford, East Lyme, Old Lyme, Stonington, Ledyard, Montville, Bozrah, Franklin, Lisbon, Norwich, Preston. Sprague.

II. RATES AND CHARGES REQUESTED

The petitioners request to increase the taxicab rate of fare:

Current \$2.00 first 1/8 mile
 .20 each additional 1/8th mile
 .20 every 36 second

Proposed

Meter Drop: \$2.25 first 1/9 mile
Travel: \$.25 each additional 1/9th mile
Waiting Time: \$.25 every 29 seconds

Pursuant to Section 4-177a of the Connecticut General Statutes, any person may request party status, if such person has submitted a written petition to the agency and mailed copies to all parties, at least five (5) days before the date of the hearing and the petition states facts that demonstrate that the petitioner’s legal rights, duties or privileges shall be specifically affected by the agency’s decision in the contested case.

In addition, any person may request intervenor status if such person has submitted a written petition to the agency and mailed copies to all parties, at least five (5) days before the date of the hearing and the petition states facts that demonstrate that the petitioner’s participation is in the interests of justice and will not impair the orderly conduct of the proceedings.

All petitions for party or intervenor status must be submitted in written form and received by this department no later than five (5) days prior to the date of hearing. Otherwise, such requested status shall be subject to denial. The five-day requirement may be waived at any time before or after the commencement of the hearing on a showing of GOOD CAUSE. Copies of any

requests for party or intervenor status must be mailed to the applicant and to all known parties.

An original and **FOUR (4) COPIES** of all prepared documents and exhibits intended to be introduced as evidence in this matter by the applicant, party, or intervenor must be filed with the department no less than **SEVEN (7) DAYS** prior to the date of hearing. All filings must be mailed to:
