Trail Highlights



This trail is a section of the Farmington River Trail, a 10.5-mile trail that begins at Meadow Road in Farmington and ends in Canton. This 5-mile section begins at Meadow Road in Farmington and travels northwest crossing Red Oak Hill Road. It then travels another 2.25 miles until it meets Route 177. After crossing Route 177, the trail parallels the Farmington River for the remainder of its length, crossing River Road and Collinsville Road along the way. The trail then reaches its terminus at the Burlington town line, where it connects with Burlington's portion of the trail.

Parking and Accessibility

No designated parking area is available for trail users.

From I-84: Take exit 39 to Route 4 West. Take a left onto Route 10 south (Main Street). Turn right (west) onto Meadow Road. At the intersection of Meadow Road and Red Oak Hill Road, go straight onto Red Oak Hill Road. The trail is approximately 0.75 miles ahead on the right.
