



Naugatuck Larkin State Park Trail

Trail Highlights

This trail is a section of a 9-mile continuous trail that begins in Southbury and ends in Naugatuck. This 1.8-mile section begins at the Middlebury town line, where it connects with the Middlebury section of the trail. The trail then goes about 0.9 miles before it intersects with Allerton Farms Road. From here the trail continues an additional 0.9 miles to its terminus at Route 63 in Whittemore Glen State Park.



Remember, horses have the right of way.

Parking and Accessibility

Parking, for 6 to 8 vehicles, is available at Whittemore Glen State Park on Route 63.

From I-84: Take exit 17 to Route 63 South. Follow Route 63 South for about 1.4 miles to Allerton Farms Road, which is on the right. The road will intersect with the trail after about 0.7 miles. Or continue on Route 63 to Whittemore Glen State Park and park at the small lot for this park.
