Project Description:

Route 11 is a state highway in east-central Connecticut, serving traffic between the Hartford and New London areas. Route 11 was originally planned to be an expressway, running northwest-to-southeast, from Colchester to Waterford. However, only about half of the expressway was constructed. The delays, and eventual effective cancellation of the project in 2009, were due to funding and environmental issues. More recently, there has been a push to complete the expressway.

The proposed extension of Route 11 would be a four-lane limited access roadway that follows an alignment from the I-95/ I-395 interchange in East Lyme and Waterford to the existing terminus of Route 11 in Salem at Route 82. The length of this alignment would be approximately 8.5 miles. In addition, approximately 3 miles of I-95 would be reconstructed to allow safe traffic movements at the interchange of Route 11, I-95 and I-395.
