5-Year Capital Plan

- The Department of Transportation develops and maintains a 5-Year Capital Plan which represents the Department's proposed program of highway and bridge, public transportation, and facility capital projects.
- The Capital Plan reflects the Department's recommended program for allocating all available state and federal capital funding to meet the state's most critical capital needs for the next five years.
- The Capital Plan includes lists of projects, by mode and by year that the Department plans to fund with its state and federal capital funds.
- The Capital Plan is a cooperative effort between the Department's operating bureaus, regional planning agencies, and the Capital Services Division within the Bureau of Finance & Administration to prioritize projects, and come up with a plan that utilizes available funds in the most efficient way.
- The Capital Plan takes into account the costs and schedules of planned projects, and the eligibility rules of the available funding sources.
- The published Capital Plan is based on a snapshot in time. Project schedules and cost estimates included in this plan were updated as of 11/30/16.
