



Rehabilitation of the William H. Putnam Bridge over the Connecticut River

WEEKEND CLOSURES SCHEDULED FOR ROUTE 3 SOUTHBOUND ON WILLIAM H. PUTNAM BRIDGE

Route 3 will have single lane closures in both directions from 7 p.m. Friday, September 27th to 6 a.m. Monday, September 30th.

Lane closures in advance of the full closure begin at 7 p.m. The work is weather and temperature sensitive and may be modified at any time. **The full closures will begin at 8 p.m. Friday and continue until 5 a.m. Monday on the following weekends:**

Friday, October 4th – Monday, October 6th


Friday, October 18th – Monday, October 21st

Project Information

The project consists of rehabilitation work on Bridge No. 0417, Putnam Bridge that includes: steel and concrete repairs, painting of structural steel, replacement of the center median barrier and the north and south parapet barriers, the addition of a sidewalk on the south side of the bridge, replacement of the existing bridge bearings and bridge joints, and the milling and resurfacing of the bridge deck.

DOT Contract No. 0053-0175 was awarded to Mohawk Northeast, Inc. of Plantsville CT on February 13, 2013 at a cost of \$30,297,746.60 and is scheduled to be completed in May 2015.
