American Recovery and Reinvestment Act 2009

Project Description:

Installation of durable epoxy pavement markings on Interstate routes as follows:

- Project 171-334 - 18.35 miles of Interstate 84 in District 1.
- Project 172-374 - 19.53 miles of Interstate 95 in District 2.
- Project 173-396 - 43.76 miles of Interstate 95 in District 3.
- Project 174-340 - 6.65 miles of Interstate 84 in District 4.

Installation of durable epoxy pavement markings on non-interstate State routes as follows:

- Project 171-338 - 65.76 miles in District 1.
- Project 172-376 - 95.20 miles in District 2.
- Project 173-400 - 62.30 miles in District 3.
- Project 174-344 - 66.96 miles in District 4.

Installation of durable epoxy pavement markings (arrows, crosswalks, etc.) on State routes at various intersections as follows:

- Project 171-337 - 67,070 square feet of markings in District 1.
- Project 172-375 - 123,972 square feet of markings in District 2.
- Project 173-399 - 263,500 square feet of markings in District 3.
- Project 174-343 - 100,815 square feet of markings in District 4.



Why it matters

- The Projects will replace pavement markings, which are faded and have decreased retro-reflectivity, with longer lasting, more prominent epoxy markings.
- The markings provide guidance and information for the drivers, promoting safer travel.
- Pavement markings also supplement and enhance other traffic control devices such as traffic signals and signs.
- Adequate legibility and retro-reflectivity of the markings are essential to the proper functions of the markings.

Solid Investment

- It provides needed maintenance of markings on all types of roadways.
- It revitalizes an important component of roadways.
- The Projects replace the markings at the end of their serviceable life.
- American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 funds allow the Projects to proceed, thus improving the State's infrastructure.



Notable Project Facts

- The Project will be put out to bid through the Department of Administration Services contract portal.
- These improvements are part of the Department's three-year continuing program of pavement marking replacement.
