Traffic Signal Installation on Slater Street at the entrances to 165 Slater Street and 120 Slater Street, in the Town of Manchester. This signal will be interconnected with the existing signal located 350 feet North at the Buckland Hills Drive/Hale Road/Slater Street/Intersection.

Why it matters

- The Project will reduce the frequency and severity of accidents.
- Improve vehicular traffic operations through and around two major shopping areas.

Solid Investment

- It revitalizes shopping in this area of Town by providing much needed safety improvements.
- The Project will create construction jobs and stimulate ancillary spending in the region.
- Jobs for subcontractors that deal in traffic signal equipment, interconnection and vehicle detection will also be created.
