


PROJECT DESCRIPTION

STATE PROJECT NO. 0135-0327 MID-BLOCK CROSSWALKS ON ROUTE 137 (WASHINGTON BOULEVARD) BETWEEN TRESSER BOULEVARD AND BROAD STREET CITY OF STAMFORD

Project Location: This project is located on State Route 137 at two separate locations in the City of Stamford. The first location (mile point 0.06) is located just south of the Bell Street intersection, and the second location (mile point 0.22) is located between Main Street and Broad Street.



Project Description: The purpose of this project is to provide pedestrian access between the east and west sides of Route 137 by installing High-intensity Activated crossWalk beacon (HAWK) systems for pedestrians. An existing crosswalk and median located just south of Bell Street would be reconfigured so that pedestrians would have a direct view of the on-coming traffic. A new mid-block crosswalk would be installed on Route 137, between Main Street and Broad Street to provide pedestrian access between the expanding Mill River Park on the west side and parking garages on the east side. Two new HAWK systems would be provided for both locations. This project also consists of curb bump-outs and median barrier with plantings, swag chains, and bollards in the median.

Rights-of-way is not anticipated for this project. However, Utility relocations may be anticipated.
