Position Description: The Hydraulics and Drainage Section in the Division of Bridges, Bureau of Engineering and Construction, in Newington, has a Transportation Engineer 2 position which is available as an internal reassignment transfer opportunity for a Transportation Engineer 2 (Engineering), Transportation Engineer 1 (Engineering), or Transportation Engineer Trainee with an Engineering target class. Applicants to the DOT's continuous recruitment postings for Transportation Engineer 2, Transportation Engineer 1 and Transportation Engineer Trainee may also be considered.

Responsibilities of this position include, but are not limited to, the preparation and/or review of computations, plans and regulatory permit applications for water resource matters related to storm drainage systems, culverts, highway or railroad bridges over waterways, dams and related facilities during the planning, design, environmental permitting or construction phases of engineering projects. This position is also responsible for performing engineering-related tasks on hydraulic and drainage activities associated with the maintenance of transportation facilities and reviewing development proposals brought before the Office of State Traffic Administration and District Permit offices. Responsibilities may also include performing field work in and around water.

Preferred Qualifications: General knowledge is desirable in the principles and practices of hydrologic and hydraulic engineering as it applies to transportation projects; ability to analyze and make recommendations on engineering problems; ability to use relevant computer software; ability to perform complex mathematical computations and to develop related technical reports. This position also requires considerable interpersonal, oral and written communication skills and considerable ability to develop, analyze and review engineering reports and plans.
