### NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY OF STATE'S DRAFT LONG-RANGE TRANSPORTATION PLAN

The Connecticut Department of Transportation (Department) has developed a draft *Long-Range Transportation Plan for the State of Connecticut (2004 LRP)* and is seeking your input.

The 2004 LRP is a federally-mandated policy document that outlines strategies and actions for addressing transportation issues and needs in Connecticut. It will serve as a framework for preparing future, more project-specific transportation plans such as the Department's 2005 Master Transportation Plan and State Transportation Improvement Program. It is generally updated every three to five years. The State's draft 2004 LRP covers the period 2004 through 2030. Public comments received during the LRP Listening Sessions and comment period in the fall of 2003 were considered in developing this plan. The Department anticipates publishing a final plan in the summer of 2004.

The draft 2004 LRP will be available at the Connecticut Department of Transportation, on the Department's website, <http://www.ct.gov/dot>, and at Connecticut's 15 Regional Planning Organizations for public review beginning on May 20, 2004. To review the document at these locations, an appointment is suggested in order to adequately schedule all interested parties. To schedule an appointment at the Department of Transportation, call (860) 594-2047.

On Tuesday, June 8, 2004, the Department will be holding two public information meetings, one in the afternoon and one in the evening, to present the draft 2004 LRP and to provide the public with an opportunity to comment on this draft document. The meeting place is handicapped accessible.
