Commuter Connections—Shore Line East To Downtown And Sargent Drive

Shore Line East “Monthly Plus Bus” tickets are accepted on Commuter Connection buses for a free ride; other passengers must pay the fare of \$1.25. Shore Line East “Monthly Plus Bus” tickets are also accepted on all other CTTRANSIT New Haven Division buses.

Temple Street Parking Garage Shuttle (To Union Station)

The fare is \$1.25; the cost for senior/disabled passengers is \$.60. Passengers may also show a Metrocard/UniTicket with Greater New Haven Transit District imprinted on the card.


