Presentation:

Ms. Calin opened the meeting with a brief introduction of Department and CME Associates personnel. She then stated the role of the Department and the role of CME Associates as liaison engineers and continued with an introduction of the subject project and its goal. Ms. Calin stated that the purpose of this public information meeting is to present the proposed design and discuss any questions, comments, or concerns the public or town officials may have.

Ms. Brais followed with the technical portion of the presentation. She described the bridge's current deficiencies, proposed rehabilitative measures, proposed locations for the temporary access roads, proposed maintenance and protection of traffic, funds, project schedule, rights-of-way, and potential environmental impacts.

Comments and Questions:

1. Will there be significant impacts to traffic on Route 66?
 - o Ms. Brais responded that most of the construction work will be done from the temporary access roads; however temporary shoulder and lane closures during off-peak hours may be necessary to deliver materials.

Adjournment:

The recommended plans provide a design for correcting the structural deficiencies of the existing bridges while minimizing the need for future maintenance. Accordingly, the Department intends to seek design approval for the proposed plan. The Department will continue to keep the Town informed of any changes that may occur as the design is being completed and will notify the Town as the project transitions into the construction phase.
