**Material Quality - General Information:**

Specification for Sodium Chloride is ConnDOT Reference File No. 139U, revised June 17, 2013

**Purity:** Minimum sodium chloride content is 95% (price adjustments applicable)

**Moisture:** Maximum moisture content is 3% (price adjustments applicable)

**Gradation:** See Specification for table (price adjustments applicable)

Salt testing for material quality occurs every 10 calendar days and is administered by the ConnDOT's, Materials Testing Laboratory. Laboratory Results are posted on this website as they occur. Laboratory tests ARE IN EFFECT UNTIL THE NEXT SUBSEQUENT TEST OCCURS. Price adjustments on deliveries falling within a given time frame when a material quality price adjustment is applicable should be applied and taken by the participating contract users. The following formula may be used to calculate price adjustment applications:

$$\frac{A}{\text{\# of Tons}} \times \$ \frac{B}{\text{Unit Price}} = \$ \frac{C}{\text{Total Dollars}} \quad \$ \frac{C}{\text{Total Dollars}} \times \frac{D}{\% \text{ of adjustment}} = \$ \frac{E}{\text{Total Adjustment}}$$

$$\frac{75}{\text{\# of Tons}} \times \$ \frac{35.00}{\text{Unit Price}} = \$ \frac{2,625.00}{\text{Total Dollars}} \quad \$ \frac{2,625.00}{\text{Total Dollars}} \times \frac{.0097}{\% \text{ of adjustment}} = \$ \frac{25.46}{\text{Total Adjustment}}$$

- For price adjustment for purposes of completing the above formula, move the decimal places 2 places to the left. For instance if a price adjustment is 1.7% then the % of adjustment in the calculation above is .0170%. If the adjustment is 2.5% then the % of price adjustment in the calculation above is .0250. If the price adjustment is .083% then the % of price adjustment in the calculation above is .00083%.
