





Safety Data System



Crash Completeness (CT-P-00006)

- Local road PDO crash reports entered into ConnDOT crash records system

Increasing the completeness of crash reporting by 49% (35,258 LRPDOs – '07)

Crash Accuracy (CT-P-00006)

- Road miles geocoded by ConnDOT allowing conversion from GPS to route and cumulative miles (2,000 miles geocoded through '08)

Improving the accuracy of crash reports by integrating with the GIS system

EMS Patient Care Report Completeness (CT-P-00001)

- Electronic PCR's submitted and entered into the DPH/OEMS system (159,596 PCR's)

Increasing the completeness of PCR's, including MV crash related PCR's

Citation/Adjudication Timeliness (CT-P-00009)

Crash Timeliness (CT-P-00006)

Current ongoing projects



In October 2008, the following six (6) projects with funding sources and modified funding amounts were subsequently proposed and agreed to by the Connecticut TRCC:

EMS PCR DCS EMS patient care reporting data collection system (408)	\$310,000
CAPTAIN Electronic PR-1 and Citation Local Law Enforce. Pilots (408)	95,000
NexGen Electronic PR-1 CSP to ConnDOT(406)	150,000
NexGen Electronic PR-1 Local Law Enforcement Pilot (408)	100,000
Electronic Citation Processing System (408)	70,000
CSP to CIB Citation Data (408)	25,000

State awarded \$380,000 first year and \$500,000 each of past two years in 408 funding

--- Monies (other funding) had been available to help support improvements

4th Year 408 App - 2009

Suggestions to-date



- Additional scanners and printers for e-citation users
- Funding for Judicial to allow e-payment of e-citations
- Crash location/Enforcement location analysis software accessible by each community
- Public policy endorsement of adding e-mail addresses on DMV records for registrations and licenses
- Open source, no cost full function accident diagramming tool for both thick and thin client users
- Additional laptops, MDTs
- Filing PR-1s using Adobe forms
- Crash data repository
