

There are two types of EPM queries in the catalog, operational and "watchdog". Operational queries provide the user with useful information from the system. "Watchdog" queries monitor data accuracy and the desired outcome is "no matching values were found." If there is output from a "watchdog" query, then corrective action must be taken.
