SUBJECT: SWIMMING POOL FEES

As required by Connecticut General Statute 19a-36 fees must be submitted with applications for pool plan reviews. A fee shall also be assessed for each resubmitted plan, swimming pool inspection and swimming pool reinspection. The fee schedule is as follows:

| 1. Initial review of pool plans               | \$600.00 |
| 2. Review of resubmitted (revised) pool plans | \$200.00 |
| 3. Conformance inspection of pools            | \$100.00 |
| 4. Reinspection of pools                      | \$ 75.00 |

#### Policy Concerning Swimming Pool Fees

A separate fee will be required for each pool reviewed. For example, if the submitted application for pool approval consists of a swimming pool, wading pool, separate diving pool and two (2) whirlpool spas, the fees for the review of this application would be \$3,000. That is a \$600.00 fee for each pool being reviewed. If this same application required revised plans to be resubmitted for the swimming pool and wading pool only then the accompanying fee would be \$400.00 for the two (2) revised plan reviews.

The above fee schedule holds true for renovations to existing previously approved pools but shall not apply to the normal maintenance and repair or the replacement of equipment which had been previously approved, provided that the type, size, and/or operating characteristics of the replacement equipment are not substantially different from the original approved equipment.

#### Method of Payment

**No cash** fees will be accepted. All checks are to be made payable to the "Treasurer, State of Connecticut".
