Ledge Light Health District offers ServSafe®, a nationally recognized food safety and education program developed by the National Restaurant Association. ServSafe® meets the CT Public Health Code requirements for Qualified Food Operators certification for food service establishments.

Our ServSafe® Certificate and Re-certification programs are taught by licensed sanitarians who are certified food inspectors.

ServSafe® Certificate and Re-certification programs are \$180.00 per person. The 8-hour class includes a ServSafe® Manager textbook, examination and a ServSafe® Food Protection Manager Certification (for individuals who pass the exam).
