



- Among 19,216 HIV/AIDS cases reported during 1982 to 2008, 13,229 (68.8%) were reported with a country of birth (or birth in a US territory such as Puerto Rico or US Virgin Islands). The majority of cases, 10,272 (77.6% of those with a known country of birth), were born in the United States with 1,863 (14.1%) born in Puerto Rico. The remaining 1,094 cases for which country of birth was reported were distributed among 96 countries with a range of 1-185 cases per country.
- A significant number of case reports (n=5,987; 31.2%) have been received with 'unknown' country of birth.
- Country of birth is incompletely reported for HIV/AIDS cases because it is not systematically recorded in medical records. Due to the number of cases for which country of birth was not reported, these data should be interpreted cautiously.
