



- The top map shows the distribution of prevalent HIV/AIDS cases (PLWHA). The inset is the same data shown as rates per 100,000 populations.
- The map on the bottom shows the number of HIV/AIDS cases diagnosed during 2005-2008. Due to a lag in reporting some cases may not be reported yet.
- Both maps illustrate the disproportionate number of HIV/AIDS cases in urban areas.
- Hartford, New Haven, and Bridgeport have the highest number of cases and the highest rates.
