- AAMR – Age adjusted mortality rates are rates that have been adjusted for differences in the age distributions between the groups (see Technical Notes link above. Click [here](#) for additional mortality data.
- Deaths due to 'HIV disease' are a subset of deaths due to 'Infectious and parasitic diseases'. For example, the 247 HIV disease deaths in the Hispanics table are included in the 412 infectious and parasitic diseases category.
