

HIV/AIDS is disproportionate among blacks and Hispanics in Connecticut, 2008



- At the end of 2008, there were 10,860 PLWHA in Connecticut (35% white, 32% black, 32% Hispanic, and 1% other).
- The population of Connecticut (US Census, 2007) is 3,494,851 (74.6% white, 9.1% black, 11.2 Hispanic, and 5.2% other).
- The prevalence rate for HIV/AIDS in Connecticut is 311 cases per 100,000 population. HIV/AIDS is disproportionate in blacks (1,093 cases per 100,000) and Hispanics (897 cases per 100,000) when compared to whites (145 per 100,000).
