ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATIONS DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH

Notice is hereby given that the Department of Public Health is adopting the policies and procedures published below concerning "Physical Plant Requirements for Child Day Care Centers and Group Day Care Homes" under the authority granted to the department by Public Act 10-90. Pursuant to the public act, notice is also hereby given, in accordance with Section 4-168(a) of the Connecticut General Statutes, that the Department of Public Health proposes these policies and procedures as an amendment to section 19a-79-7a of the Regulations of the Connecticut State Agencies.

Statement of Purpose:


(A) the purpose of this regulation is to amend the regulations governing child day care centers and group day care homes to establish physical plant requirements for programs that exclusively serve school age children and comply with the mandates of Public Act 10-90, (B) this regulation waives or reduces some physical plant requirements for programs that serve exclusively school age children, and (C) this regulation will repeal section 19a-13-B27a and create sections 19a-428-1 through 19a-428-7.

Persons wishing to present their views and arguments regarding these regulations are invited to do so in writing within thirty (30) days of publication of this notice. A public hearing will be scheduled if requested by fifteen (15) or more persons, a governmental subdivision or agency, or an association having not less than fifteen (15) members, provided that notice of such request is made within (30) thirty days of publication of this notice to: Commissioner of Public Health, Department of Public Health, 410 Capitol Avenue, MS #13COM, P.O.
