The Connecticut Water/Wastewater Agency Response Network (**CtWARN**) is a network of “utilities helping utilities.” This network helps water and wastewater utilities locate emergency assistance in the form of personnel, equipment, materials and other services. **CtWARN** is proudly hosting a free event that includes an emergency response seminar and a tabletop exercise (TTX).

Emergency Response Seminar and TTX Description: The event will consist of a seminar with presentations and a TTX. The seminar presentations will cover topics related to **CtWARN**, as well as water and wastewater preparedness and response. The TTX will be based on a hypothetical incident designed to bring together water, wastewater, county and state agencies, and public safety to discuss roles and responsibilities during an incident. This seminar and TTX are open to member utilities and non-member utilities, as well as response partners that are interested in learning more about **CtWARN**.

Training Contact Hours (TCHs): An application will be made for Connecticut water and wastewater operators to earn TCHs toward their license renewal requirements for their participation in the entire event.
