Consolidating Analyte Codes:

Color:	SCL/COLR	to	1905
Turbidity:	DTRB/TURB	to	0100
Odor:	SOD	to	1920
pH:	SPH	to	1925
E. coli:	REC	to	3014

- 💧 Change will be effective for all samples collected after 12/31/2016
- 💧 Monitoring schedules are starting to be updated
- 💧 Complete list of analyte codes/groups have been posted

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CMDP

Compliance Monitoring Data Portal (CMDP)

What: Web-based application that allows the electronic reporting of compliance sample results

Who: Certified laboratories
Public Water Systems
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How: XML File Uploads
Online Data Entry
Offline Excel Templates (to create and upload XML)
Web Services

When: Pre-Production (Testing) and Production environments are available now

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CMDP

Two Environments

Pre-Production: A testing environment for users to become familiar with the CMDP and test XML files. Connected to the DWS SDWIS-Staging database.

Production: The Production environment is used to submit compliance data to the DWS. Connected to the DWS SDWIS database.



CMDP

Transition from EDI to CMDP

- Transition can begin now
- Lab and PWS Administrators will request credentials to the Pre-Production System
- Lab and PWS Administrators will be approved by the State Administrator
- Additional Lab and PWS staff will request credentials and be approved by the Lab and PWS Administrators

CMDP

XML File Uploads

- In order to use this option, Labs and PWS will need to be able to create XML files from their current reporting system/LIMS or use the offline Excel templates
- Excel templates will create XML Files for submittal when properly completed
- XML Schema is documented in Sample Data Dictionary
- XML files should be tested in CMDP Pre-Production
- Once the Lab/PWS has tested and successfully submitted compliance data, credentials can be requested to access the Production environment

CMDP

Web Forms

- This reporting option is best suited to submit small amounts of data
- May be the best option for Labs with fewer clients
- Data is typed into online forms and validated immediately, reducing potential reporting errors
- Forms can be completed and saved online
- Multiple forms can be submitted in one job
- Surface water systems will be instructed to report their monthly surface water reports using web forms

CMDP

Obtaining Access to CMDP Pre-Production

- *CMDP Role Registration User Guide* is available in the CMDP Help Center (<https://cmdp.zendesk.com>)
- All users must request CMDP access through EPA CROMERR Shared Services (SCS):

<https://test.epacdx.net/EPASharedServicesPortal/>

- **Username must be different if you were previously a tester**
- The State CMDP Administrator will review and approve all Lab and PWS Administrator requests
- After testing, Lab and PWS Administrators can request access to the Production environment
