

In regards to the email dated 5/3/10 that identifies the City of Stamford project as priority 16, I am providing DPH with written comments on the proposed final ranking of this project no later than 4:30 p.m. on June 1, 2010.

The City of Stamford believes that the project submitted should be reviewed again to qualify for additional points within the application previously submitted to your office on March 31, 2010.

Based upon my further review of the application, I believe that it is appropriate to check off items I and W on pages 5 and 6 rendering 50 additional points.

Item I applies (30 points) as existing well water in the area has been tested and contains pesticides. Public water supplied to this area will correct these deficiencies.

Item W applies (20 points) as connection to a proposed public water supply will replace existing well water in areas of know contamination.

I respectfully request that you review these written comments for consideration in receiving additional points. We are willing to attend tomorrow's public hearing if you think this will help the City's position.
