What does this mean?

Inadequately treated or inadequately protected water may contain disease-causing organisms. *Fecal indicators are microbes whose presence indicates that the water may be contaminated with human or animal wastes. Microbes in these wastes can cause short-term health effects, such as diarrhea, cramps, nausea, headaches, or other symptoms. They may pose a special health risk for infants, young children, some of the elderly, and people with severely compromised immune systems.*

What should I do?

You are urged to take the precautions indicated below before any human consumption of water including: drinking, food preparation, making coffee or ice, dishwashing, or the brushing of teeth. Please consult your physician if you have any medical questions or concerns.

- Boiling the water for one minute to inactivate any bacteria that may be present; OR
- Using bottled water or an alternate source of approved drinking water.
