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**Please note the following:**

1. All water quality monitoring results submitted to the Drinking Water Section (DWS) must include the information identifying the Water System Facility and the Sampling Point.
2. The residual disinfectant concentration must be measured at the same location and time as each total coliform sample and reported to the DWS, in accordance with RCSA 19-13-B102(e)(7)(A).
3. If a "Seasonal Collection Period" is specified, all water quality samples collected for compliance purposes must be collected during this period (i.e. Total Trihalomethanes, Total Haloacetic Acids, and Lead and Copper requirements).
4. Depending on results, additional monitoring may be required (i.e. repeat or confirmation samples). This schedule is subject to change, and any related correspondence sent by the DWS on or after the generation date of this schedule will have precedence over what is contained in this schedule.
5. Monthly summaries of chlorine residual, pH, orthophosphates, etc., are due no later than the ninth day of the following month.
6. Any owner or operator of a public water system must maintain records in accordance with the RCSA Section 19-13-B102(l).
