Attached is a survey regarding potential changes to Sec. 19-13-B51, Sec. 19-13-B101. I am requesting that each health department review, comment and return the completed survey by email or by regular mail.

I have broken out the items into specific areas for B51 because so many individuals over the years have been concerned of various aspects of this regulation. Please keep in mind we are anticipating making a section dedicated to private well variances, basically allowing local health, through the Department of Public Health to make variances in existing conditions.
