

Training Opportunities for Connecticut Certified Food Inspectors 2016

The Connecticut Public Health Code requires that certified food inspectors complete sixteen (16) contact hours of approved food protection training every three (3) years. Available training with contact hours that can be applied towards food inspector recertification include:

June 9, 2016

- **Evaluating Sous Vide and Acidification of Sushi Rice**

Presented by the DPH Food Protection Program at Lyceum Conference Center, Hartford. Two back to back ½ day sessions are planned to provide inspectors with information to assess the regulatory compliance of these two processes that will become effective when pending regulations are approved. See Circular Letter # 2016-14 for details. *Five (5) contact hours will be awarded toward food inspector recertification for attendance at this training and completion of the required FDA prerequisite online courses.*
