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

- Fees/tax on insurers, pharma, medical devices, etc.


Transparency

Goals of health care reform?

- Reduce uninsured
- Reduce health care costs
- Focus on primary care & preventive care
- Align incentives so we “pay” for performance & quality:
 - Evidence-based medicine
 - Comparative effectiveness research
- Delivery system reforms:
 - Bundling payments
 - Re-organizing the system structure

System of Care Under Transition



Healthcare Acquired Infections

To reduce/eliminate:

- Evidence-based practices
- Comparative effectiveness research
- Align incentives so payment is for outcome

Planning Considerations:

- Population shift of insured & location of access (influx of individuals into system)
- Hospitals response to health care reforms that relate to infections and re-admissions
