

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Key Findings

- Overall, one out of every seven (13.9%) Connecticut public school students has asthma. The asthma prevalence rates have significantly increased over time, from 13.2% in 2006 to 14.2% in 2011.
- Asthma prevalence rates were significantly higher among elementary school students (14.6%) and middle school students (14.5%) when compared to high school students (12.8%).
- The asthma prevalence rate for male students (15.5%) was significantly higher than for female students (12.1%).
- Hispanic students (17.2%) and non-Hispanic black students (16.7%) had significantly higher rates of asthma when compared to non-Hispanic white students (11.2%) and other non-Hispanic students (11.5%).
- District Reference Groups (DRG), with letters A to I, classify school districts of similar socioeconomic status (SES). SES decreases with each letter from A to I, and asthma rates increased with decreasing SES. Asthma prevalence rates ranged from 7.7% among students in DRG A to 19.9% among students in DRG I. Four of the five largest cities (Bridgeport, Hartford, New Haven, and Waterbury) along with New Britain, New London, and Windham belonged to group I.
- Overall, 12.1% of students with asthma had moderate or severe persistent asthma. When compared to non-Hispanic white students (10.5%), non-Hispanic black students (14.7%) had a 40% more chance of being classified as having moderate or severe persistent asthma. Other non-Hispanic students (13.7%) and Hispanic students (13.1%) also had 30% and 25%, respectively, more chances of being classified as having moderate or severe persistent asthma than their non-Hispanic white student counterparts.
- Overall, 7.8% of students with asthma had an Asthma Action Plan (AAP). Presence of an AAP increased from 5.1% in 2009 to 9.5% in 2011. About one in ten (9.5%) non-Hispanic black students with asthma had an AAP, followed by non-Hispanic white students (7.6%), other non-Hispanic students (7.2%), and Hispanic students (7.0%). Students with moderate or severe persistent asthma (19.0%) were about twice more likely to have an AAP than those with intermittent (9.7%) or mild persistent (9.3%) asthma.

Introduction

Pursuant to Connecticut General Statute (CGS) Section 10-206, the State of Connecticut Department of Public Health (DPH) Asthma Program has established a statewide School-based Asthma Surveillance System (SBASS) based on the school Health Assessment Record (HAR). The statute also requires the Asthma Program to report findings from this surveillance effort to the joint standing committees of the General Assembly every three years. This report summarizes the information collected during school years 2009-2010, 2010-2011 and 2011-2012.

Description of the School-based Asthma Surveillance System

CGS §10-206 requires that public schools annually report to the DPH information on students with asthma. A student is considered as having asthma if he/she meets any of the following conditions: 1) has a provider's diagnosis of asthma indicated on the HAR, 2) has a provider Asthma Action Plan (AAP) on file, 3) has a provider medication order for asthma medication on file, 4) has self-carry medication approval, 5) has asthma medication in school, 6) has a parental note on file indicating the child has asthma, 7) shows symptoms of asthma, or 8) any other indications that the child is suffering from asthma.

Information on students with asthma include: school, grade, age, gender, race, ethnicity, asthma documentation, asthma severity, and health history. This information is only reported for students with asthma in grades requiring the HAR: prior to public school entrance (Pre-Kindergarten [PK] or Kindergarten [K] for elementary schools); in grade 6 or 7 for middle schools; and in grade 9 or 10 for high schools. In order to facilitate this process, DPH and the State Department of Education (SDE) developed reporting forms for use by school nurses. At the beginning of each school year, these forms are distributed to individual school nurses through the school district nurse supervisors. School district nurse supervisors then collect the completed forms in their school districts and submit them to DPH by September of the subsequent school year. All data are entered into the SBASS, a Microsoft Access database, by trained DPH staff. Data quality checks are then performed to ensure the accuracy and completeness of the data entered.

Method for Asthma Rate Calculations

Each local or regional board of education chooses which grades require an HAR based on the options provided by the legislation. More specifically, it is up to the school district to decide whether to require an HAR for students in grades PK or K, 6 or 7, and 9 or 10. School nurses are required to submit to DPH asthma data on the grades that require an HAR only, but some submit data on other grades as well. School district nurse supervisors are asked to report specifically which grades required an HAR in their school districts.

Asthma rates were calculated by dividing the number of students with asthma by the total number of children enrolled in the required grades of the school district. However, for some school districts, it was still unclear which grades to include in the rates calculation because the grades specified by the school district nurse supervisors as requiring an HAR differed from the grades that were actually reported for students with asthma. For example, a school district may have indicated that grade 6 was the required grade for asthma data submission, and while some nurses within the school district submitted asthma data for grade 6, others may have submitted asthma data for grade 7 instead. In other instances, the school district may have indicated that both grades 6 and 7 were the required grades for asthma data submission, but only grade 6 asthma data was submitted. In these instances it was very difficult to decipher which grades in the school district should be used in the calculation of asthma rates.

In light of these issues, the following steps were taken to calculate asthma rates for each school district: First, only public schools with enrollment data obtained from SDE were included in the rates calculation (98% of the reporting public schools met this criterion). Second, the grades with the highest number of students reported as having asthma at the elementary, middle, and high school level for each school were included for rate calculations. Specifically, for each school, the grade with the highest number of students with asthma in grade PK or K was selected for elementary school rates calculation. The grade with the highest number of students with asthma in grade 5, 6, or 7 was selected for middle school rate calculations (some school districts reported grade 5). The grade with the highest number of students with asthma in grade 9, 10, or 11 was selected for high school rate calculations. This methodology ensured that the appropriate grades for each school are used in rate calculations. For some schools that reported multiple grades for each school level of entry, it was hypothesized that the grades with the highest number of students reported as having asthma represented the more complete and accurate reports than the other grades.

For the calculation of the elementary school level asthma rate, 89% of the reports used were of grade K and 11% were of grade PK. For the middle school level rate calculation, 77% of the reports used were of grade 6, 22% were of grade 7, and 1% were of grade 5. For the high school level rate calculation, 68% of the reports used were of grade 10, 28% were of grade 9, and 4% were of grade 11. In addition to the asthma prevalence rate, a 95% confidence interval (CI) was generated for each rate. Testing for statistical significance was done at the $p < 0.05$ level.

For all other information in this report that did not involve the use of enrollment data to calculate rates, analyses were performed based on all grades (PK – 12). The elementary school level was considered to consist of grades PK – 5, middle school level was grades 6 – 8, and high school level was grades 9 – 12.

Comparison to Previous Report

The current method of asthma rates calculation is comparable to the previous report: “Connecticut School-based Asthma Surveillance Report 2010, School Years: Fall 2006 – Spring 2009” (http://www.ct.gov/dph/lib/dph/hems/asthma/pdf/school_base_asthma_surveillance_report_2010.pdf)

Results

Henceforward, the school years will be referred to only by the beginning school year. For example, the 2009-2010 school year will be referred to as the 2009 school year. The numbers of school districts which submitted asthma reports for the 2009, 2010 and 2011 school years were 187 (96.9%), 188 (97.4%) and 188 (97.4%), respectively. For the purpose of this report, school districts included regional districts, magnet schools, charter schools, and regional education service centers. A total of 1,159 schools reported 21,240 students with asthma for the 2009 school year. A total of 1,142 schools reported 21,398 students with asthma for the 2010 school year. For the 2011 school year, 1,176 schools reported 22,202 students with asthma. For a listing of reporting schools for each school year, please refer to Appendix 1.

Asthma Prevalence


Information on asthma prevalence by school year, school level, gender, and race/ethnicity are shown in Table 1. Overall, one out of every seven (13.9%) Connecticut public school students has asthma. The asthma prevalence rates have significantly increased over time, from 13.2% in 2006 (data from previous report) to 13.7% in 2009 and then to 14.2% in 2011. Asthma prevalence rates were significantly higher among elementary school students (14.6%) and middle school students (14.5%) when compared to high school students (12.8%). The asthma prevalence rate for male students (15.5%) was significantly higher than for female students (12.1%). With regard to asthma prevalence rates by race/ethnicity, Hispanic students (17.2%) and non-Hispanic black students (16.7%) had significantly higher rates of asthma when compared to non-Hispanic white students (11.2%) and other non-Hispanic students (11.5%). Please note

that 6.4% of students were reported as having an unknown race/ethnicity category; therefore, asthma prevalence rates by race/ethnicity groups may be underestimated. Table 2 shows asthma prevalence rates by school year, gender and race/ethnicity for elementary, middle and high schools.

Asthma Prevalence by District Reference Groups



Asthma prevalence rates by District Reference Groups (DRG) are shown in Figure 1. DRG is a classification system established by the SDE in which districts that have public school students with similar socioeconomic status (SES) and need were grouped together. The 2006 DRG classifications were based on seven variables: income, parent's education, occupation (of student's parents), family structure, poverty, home language, and district enrollment.¹ In general, SES decreases with each letter from A to I, and asthma rates increased with decreasing SES. The asthma prevalence rates ranged from 7.7% among students in DRG A to 19.9% among

students in DRG I. Four of the five largest cities (Bridgeport, Hartford, New Haven, and Waterbury) along with New Britain, New London, and Windham belonged to group I, whose asthma prevalence rate was significantly higher than any other DRG. Conversely, the asthma prevalence rate for DRG A was significantly lower than any other DRG. It should be noted that a quarter (25.0%) of the students with asthma were attending schools in the lowest DRG (I) and over half (51.8%) of students with asthma were attending schools in the three lowest DRG (G, H and I; data not shown). Table 3 shows the asthma prevalence rates by school level, gender and race/ethnicity for each DRG.

Asthma Severity

Based on the National Heart, Lung, and Blood Institute (NHLBI) guidelines, asthma severity is classified into the following four categories: intermittent, mild persistent, moderate persistent and severe persistent. The level of asthma severity is determined by frequency of asthma symptoms, nighttime awakenings, short-acting Beta₂-agonist use, interference with normal activity, and lung function. The treatment of asthma is in part dictated by the different levels of asthma severity. For more information regarding asthma severity and its treatment, please visit the Expert Panel Report 3 (EPR 3) Guidelines for the Diagnosis and Management of Asthma.²

For the purpose of this report, and due to small proportion of students with asthma classified as having either moderate or severe persistent asthma, asthma severity was combined into the following three categories: intermittent, mild persistent, and moderate or severe persistent. Also, the DPH Asthma Program initiated the collection of this categorization of asthma severity in the 2010 school year, so only two years (2010 and 2011) of data were available. Table 4 shows asthma severity by school year, school type, school level, gender, race/ethnicity, and DRG.

proportion of students classified as having moderate or severe persistent asthma increased with each DRG from B to I.

Overall, 12.1% of students with asthma had moderate or severe persistent asthma. This level of asthma severity was 13.3% in 2010 and 10.9% in 2011. Students in public schools (12.2%) were slightly more likely to be classified as having moderate or severe persistent asthma than those in the private schools (11.1%). Younger students were more likely to be classified as having moderate or severe persistent asthma (12.5% for elementary schools, 12.1% for middle school, and 11.5% for high schools). Not much difference was observed between males (12.2%) and females (11.8%). When compared to non-Hispanic white students (10.5%), non-Hispanic black students (14.7%) had a 40% more chance of being classified as having moderate or severe persistent asthma. Other non-Hispanic students (13.7%) and Hispanic students (13.1%) also had a 30% and 25%, respectively, more chances of being classified as having moderate or severe persistent asthma than their non-Hispanic white student counterparts. With the exception of DRG A, the

Asthma Action Plan

According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, everyone with asthma should have an asthma action plan (AAP).³ An asthma action plan is a management plan developed with the doctor to help the client control his/her asthma. The AAP lists all medications with instructions on when they should be taken. It is a simple plan that describes how to achieve long-term control and what to do when asthma symptoms arises. The plan can be filled out electronically using the form developed by DPH Asthma Program, and it can be found online on DPH Asthma program website <http://www.ct.gov/dph/asthma>.

Table 5 shows that overall, 7.8% of students with asthma had an AAP. That percentage increased from 5.1% in 2009 to 9.5% in 2011. Public school students with asthma had a lower chance of having an AAP (7.6%) than those in private schools (9.8%). Younger students with asthma were more likely to have an AAP (8.8% for elementary schools, 8.1% for middle schools, and 6.2% for high schools). No difference was observed between males (7.8%) and females (7.9%). About one in ten (9.5%) non-Hispanic black students with asthma had an AAP, followed by non-Hispanic white students (7.6%), other non-Hispanic students (7.2%), and Hispanic students (7.0%). Students with moderate or severe persistent asthma (19.0%) were about twice more likely to have an AAP than those with intermittent (9.7%) or mild persistent (9.3%) asthma. There appears to be no correlation between having an AAP and where the students attend schools as defined by DRG.

Asthma Documentation and Health History

Table 6 shows percentage of students with various types of asthma documentation, as well as their health histories reported by their parents or guardians on the HAR. Four out of every five students (80.9%) with asthma had a provider diagnosis indicated on the HAR; one out of every three students (32.8%) had a provider medication order for asthma medication on file; 8.4% had self-carry medication approval; 25.8% had asthma medication in school; 34.0% had a parental note on file indicating the child has asthma; 8.7% showed symptoms of asthma; and 3.7% had other indications that the child is suffering from asthma. A quarter of the students (24.6%) with asthma were indicated by their parents/guardians as having problem breathing or coughing, and two out of every five students (41.4%) had asthma treatment during the past three years.
